A pod of whales stranded during low tide and an approaching asteroid are no match for Supermoon, who faithfully protects the planet "through its darkest hours." With a red cape with a crescent-moon clasp, Supermoon's expressive face and dramatic poses stand out against nighttime backdrops; fun facts about the moon round out the text for budding astronomers.
