Bear's best friend, a little bird, has died; Bear carves a beautiful box for him and cushions his friend with wildflowers, but none of the other animals understand why he continues to carry the box around. When Bear comes across a wandering wildcat, he finds understanding, acceptance, and the courage to take the next step.
